The month in brief

March 2026 brought steady movement in cybersecurity legislation, with fourteen bills advancing across eight states and three reaching the governor's desk. Mississippi, Rhode Island, and West Virginia each enacted measures addressing election security, state cybersecurity programs, and standards for election management systems. Florida advanced two bills on cybersecurity education and local government cyber requirements, while Maryland moved forward with proposals on cybersecurity compliance and critical infrastructure protection. Connecticut reported out two data security measures, and several other states saw committee action on encryption, breach notification, and education-related cybersecurity policies.
